

HORSE ACCEPTANCE/RELEASE FORM

By signing this form you are releasing your horse to Wasatch Humane. The information requested below is to assure the proper care of the incoming horse and the safety of the current residential horses. The following conditions must be met before the horse is accepted by Wasatch Humane.

The Intake Interview Form is to be filled out completely, and then returned to us to be decided upon by Wasatch Humane. (We have this for Rusty from Best Friends)

After Wasatch Humane has decided to take your horse, this form, "The Horse Acceptance/Release Form" is to be signed and returned/mailed back with the following:

A veterinarian's certificate stating the horse has been recently Coggin's tested and found negative for Equine Infectious Anemia.

Any and all previous veterinary/medical records – including floating, deworming, vaccinations etc.

Information on what you have been feeding your horse, hay amounts, supplements etc.

3. We may require for you to provide the transportation of the horse to the quarantine facility at a prearranged time and date.

Any financial arrangements (charitable donation) for the continuing support of the horse that you are able to make.
